





Functionality: Develop a space that can be used for various community activities, workshops, and events.


Aesthetics: Create an aesthetically pleasing and visually appealing space that aligns with our organization's values.

ABOUT OUR DESIGN

The goal of this project is to make a place that shows off sustainable design and waste management in the construction industry. So, we created a spot on college and school grounds to teach students and visitors about it as well as enjoy and connect with the space.

The spot fits around 6-7 people and is partly covered with jute ropes and broken pvc pipes, all nicely finished so it works for covering most of our structure's top part. For the bottom part, we poured concrete blocks right onto the ground, making a solid foundation that'll last for many seasons.

This spot will entertain and educate visitors on how recycling and reusing materials can be good while also promoting eco-friendly ways to build .

Turning waste into any kind of space or useful thing not only helps cut down on construction waste but also contributes to the betterment of environment.

Having a interactive space like this near college and school make a good impact.



















MATERIALS USED


Once we figured out how to create and understand the model for the interactive space, our main focus was sorting out the materials. We made a list of all the materials needed for construction. Our main goal was to use construction waste materials. So, we narrowed down our choices to these specific materials.Grey Pvc Pipe ,Rope ,Bamboo ,Cement,Tiles ,Steel bars ,Paint buckets .

With this in mind, our team set off on a scavenger hunt to find all the necessary construction waste materials. We hit up scrap shops, under-construction sites, recently finished buildings, hardware stores, even people's personal houses – anywhere we could get our hands on what we needed. We managed to collect things like leftover cement bags, steel bars, tiles and bamboo from building sites; paint buckets and ropes from scrap shops; and some odds and ends from hardware stores that had no use for them. And that's how we gathered all the material required for building this interactive space.

Reused harden concrete blocks by further crushing it so that it can be converted into PCC layer. Bars of 12 mm thickness which were wasted on the construction site were retrieved and casted into stools for strengthening as well as acts as legs.

Jute is used for binding the bamboo together for the main structure. Further used for jali pattern created for making an encloser for the structure.

Bamboo is used as main structural component. By binding them together and casted into PCC bed at bottom. which was also brought from the construction site itself.




CONCLUSION:

आदरणीय श्री. विजय लिमये सरांनी मागील दहा वर्षांपासून पर्यावरणपुरक अंत्यसंस्कार या क्षेत्रात अमूल्य योगदान दिले आहे. पंचतत्वांनी बनानेले शरीर घेऊन जन्माला आलेला मनुष्य पर्यावरणासोबत जगतो आणि शेवटी त्याच पंचतत्वात विलीन होतो. मात्रआपल्या जीवनप्रवासात कायमच सोवत असलेल्या पर्यावरणाचा ऱ्हास मानवाच्या हातून कळत नकळतपणे होत असतो. या भावनेने आपले सामाजिक ऋण समजून व्यवसायाने अभियंता असूनही काही कल्पना अमलातही आणल्या. कोणत्याही स्मशानभूमीत प्रत्येक दहनासाठी सध्या पंधरा वर्ष वयाच्या दोन झाडांना जीव गमवावा लागतो हे प्रमाण मर्यादित करणेमाठी आपण मोक्षकाष्ठ' या पर्यायी इंधनाचा विचार केला. कृषी क्षेत्रातील कचऱ्यापासून मोक्षकाष्ठ निर्माण करून त्याचा अंत्यसंस्कारासाठी इंधन माणून वापर करण्याचे सरांचे हे आगळे-वेगळे संशोधन कौतुकास्पद आहे. या पद्धतीने दहन केल्यानंतर तयार झालेली रक्षा, वाया न जाता झाडांच्या मुळात

खत म्हणून वापरता येते. वनस्पतीला लागणारे जवळपास सर्व पोषक घटक या राखेत असतात. याबाबतचे त्यांचे विशेष योगदान दिसून येते, ते स्वर्गद्वार या नागप्रमधील अंबाझरी दहन घाटाच्या सुशोभीकरणाच्या प्रकल्पामध्ये. 'स्वर्गद्वार' हि स्मशानभूमी सुशोभीकरणाची संकल्पना वास्तवामधील एक उल्लेखनीय उपक्रम म्हणावा लागेल. अंबाझरी दहन घाट स्वच्छ आणि सुंदर करण्यासाठी केलेले अतुलनीय प्रयत्न व निसर्गाची कमीत कमी हानी होईल याची घेतलेली दक्षता व स्वर्गद्वाराचे वातावरण प्रसन्न राहावे यासाठी स्मशानभूमीत फुलझाडांच्या लागवडीचा विचार करणे हे खूपच प्रशंसनीय म्हणावे लागेल, तमेच अंबाझरी स्वर्गद्वार येथे एक टन रक्षा सामावेल इतके मोठे रक्षा कलशही आपण उभे केले आहेत, तसे काम करताना पर्यावरणपुरक पद्धतीचे विविध प्रयोग तसेच कचऱ्यातून कला, पुनर्वापर, याचे आदर्श उदाहरण प्रस्थापित केले आहे. नैसर्गिक साधनसंपत्तीचा गैरवापर टाळण्यासाठी जे-जे करावे लागेल ते करण्याचा प्रयत्न व प्लास्टिक पिशव्यांना पर्याय म्हणून कापडी पिशव्या उत्पादन आणि त्या वापरण्यासाठी केलेले जनजागरण यातून लिमये सरांचे पर्यावरण संवर्धनाचे संवेदनशील प्रयत्न

दिसून येतात. Reduce, Reuse and Recycle अर्थात कमीतकमी वापर, पुनर्वापर, आणि पुनक्रिया या नियमांचा आधार घेऊन हरित सृष्टी निर्माण करण्याचा हा उपक्रम म्हणजे नक्कीच पर्यावरण संवर्धनासाठी एक उत्तम उदाहरण आहे. निसर्ग निरीक्षण आणि निसर्ग रक्षणाची बालपणापासूनच आवड जोपासली. अभियांत्रिकीचे शिक्षण पूर्ण करून सर आज विमा सर्वेक्षक आणि मूल्यांकनकर्ता, सरकार मान्यताप्राप्त मूल्यनिर्मांकन सनदीअभियंता म्हणून कार्यरत आहेत. इको-फ्रेंडली लिव्हिंग फाऊंडेशन या अशासकीय संस्थेच्या माध्यमातून सरांनी कित्येक कामगारांना रोजगार उपलब्ध करून दिले.
